In 2020 despite being in the midst of a pandemic, over 3,000 individuals received services from ACS organizations. ACS organizations are not affiliated with the United Way of Dane County.

Ninety-five percent of the dollars we received in 2020 went directly to help people with disabilities and other challenges. One hundred percent of the contributions to ACS stay right in Dane County.
